# Time & Balance

On behalf of the Bibleway Churches UK national women's department I would like to welcome you to our national women's conference 2024, as we enter 'His presence' together with anticipation and excitement of another awesome experience. The national team would like to extend a heartfelt thank you to the host church, Abundant Life, and our host women's' presidents, Lady Yvonne McIntosh, Elder Lorna Chevannes, and the saints, whose hospitality has always been warm and welcoming. The principal aim of our national women's team endeavours to be 'connection' and it is our hope to continue to build stronger links with the women's ministry teams within our churches and just as essential, to connect with the communities in which we serve.

The theme for our conference this year is 'Time and Balance' and our key verse is found in Psalm 46:10 [a] 'Be still, and know that I am God.' In our still moments, when the Lord has us to Himself, without distraction, we can then say 'speak [Lord] for your servant hears' 1 Samuel 3:10 as when the Lord called the young boy Samuel: Only when Samuel became still, could he hear the voice of the Lord, only when Elijah was still, could he hear the 'still small voice' of revelation of the Lord, 1 Kings 19: 11-13. On the lonely, isolated Isle of Patmos, the exiled disciple John received the content of the book of the Revelation of Jesus Christ, and in John 4, a solitary, unpopular woman at a well, had a divine encounter with

## A word of welcome from our National Women's President

Jesus, who revealed to her in that moment that He was the awaited Messiah, 'Jesus said to her, 'I who speak to you am He,' John 4: 26. In your most painful and loneliest moments, listen for the still, soft, small voice of revelation, as the Lord will open up His word to you, to enable you to live out your life in the full purpose and plans that He has for you. The influence of a person who has been in the presence of the Lord cannot be underestimated, atmospheres have to change as you enter the room, if you will be still in His presence, for a moment.

The national team have endeavoured not to 'over pack' our conference, as we believe it is important to give as much time as possible to our morning and afternoon seminars and sharing, to pause for a moment, and receive comfort in our fellowship with each other.

As we remember loved ones that are no longer with us this year, our hearts are thankful for their legacies of love and sacrifice but also heavy with an awareness that the baton is in our hands now, and conscious that we need to keep the next generation close to ensure we can pass the baton on when their time comes.

Many believe we are now firmly in the last days and women have a vital role to play in these end times. In Joel 2:28 we read that in the last days '[...] your sons and you daughters shall prophecy [...] and in verse 29, 'and also on My menservants and on My maidservants, I will pour out My Spirit in those days'. The rise of women in ministry is another sign that we are in the last days, men led the way, due to the order of creation, however the rise of women in ministry is a prophetic sign that we

now see being fulfilled due to the end time era in which we currently live. Another vital role of women in ministry is seen in Matthew 26 vs 7, 'a woman came to Him [Jesus] having an alabaster flask of very costly fragrant oil, and she poured it on His head as He sat at meat'. This unnamed woman anointed Jesus' living body 'in preparation for transition', and I have heard a preacher link this event in with the women's end time role, in that we are 'preparing the body for transition'.

I must thank the national women's team and the local presidents of our churches for their continued support over the last year in our monthly prayer line and planning meetings for the conference. The fellowship we have during these meetings continues to be a source of strength to me as we serve together. I would like to mention once again, a special thanks to one of our treasures, deaconess Tracey-Ann, who helps to keep us structured and in order with her timely minutes of all our meetings, we value her immensely. A special thanks to our two vice presidents, 'queen Regina Robinson' and sister Deborah Palmer whose love, support, and guidance I value and the two regional presidents, missy Paulette Jackson and sis Vern Mussington, the team is stronger for you both.

I pray that this conference will be all that we hoped and prayed for and more, that we will search our hearts, share, love, cry, and then stand, stronger than before.

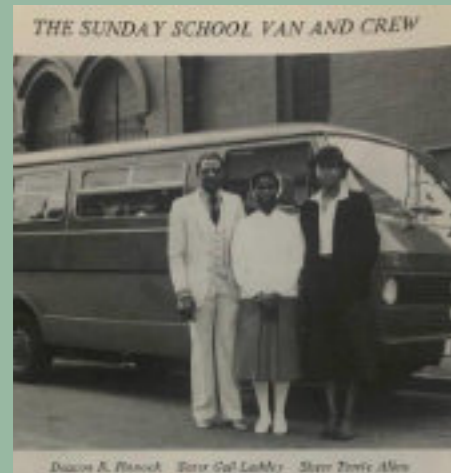

Every Friday was our youth meeting, and as young people when we got together, we encouraged each other and were on fire for the lord.

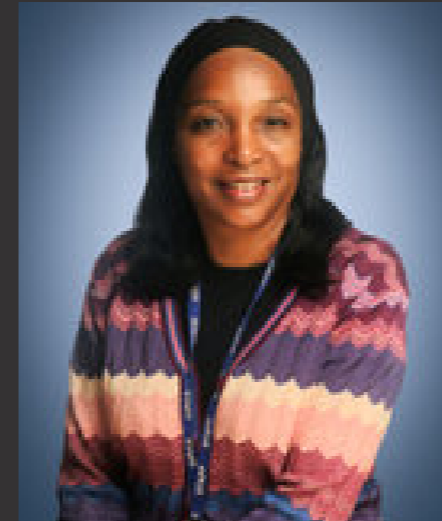

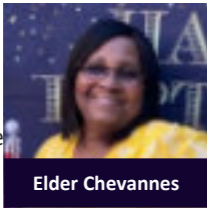

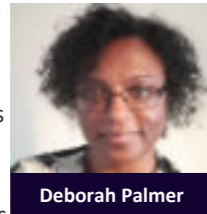
Elder Lorna Whyte-Chevannes was born in Kingston Jamaica in 1951; she is the second child and came to England in 1976 to look after her mother.

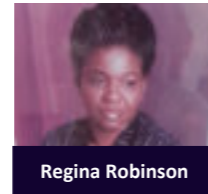
Deborah Palmer

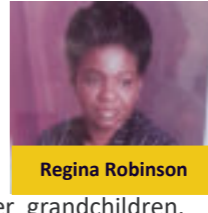

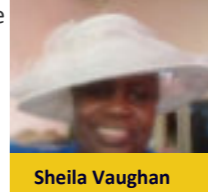
