You will be blessed when you go out.



DAY OF ATONEMENT



Bishop E Copeland

In November 2020, Bibleway Churches held a national day of Atonement. Under the leading of the Holy Spirit, we were called together to repent and ask God to forgive us of our sins and cleanse us by the efficacious blood of Jesus Christ. It was a blessing and we have seen the wonderful move of God among us.

Set out below is an outline of the biblical basis for the day of atonement.

Yom Kippur—the day of atonement is the second of the three fall feasts (Leviticus 16 and 23:26).

This shall be a permanent statute for you: in the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, you shall humble your souls and not do any work, whether the native, or the alien

who sojourns among you; for it is on this day that atonement shall be made for you to cleanse you; you will be clean from all your sins before the LORD thy God.

It is to be a sabbath of solemn rest for you, that you may humble your souls; it is a permanent statute. “So the priest who is anointed and ordained to serve as priest... shall make atonement: He shall also make atonement for the priests and for all the people of the assembly. Now you shall have this as a permanent statute, to make atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once every year” (Leviticus 16:29-34).

The Commandments were the only thing that separated Israel; to make them separate and holy.

When Moses, the mediator; was up on Mt Sinai, even after all the miracles God had just done for Israel; they corrupted themselves with worldly revelry and quickly turned aside from the way God commanded by making a religion of worshipping the golden calf.

Nothing can separate us from the love of God”.

God knew how prone to evil and obstinate the people were (Exodus 32:33). The Day of Atonement was the process by which their names would be reinstated in His book of life for another year by the covering of their sins in the blood.

Jesus Christ is our Yom Kippur priest and the once

and for all sacrifice to die for our atonement —the covering and removal of our sins. “For it was fitting for us to have such a high priest exalted above the heavens, who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the sins of the people, because this He did once for all when He offered up Himself” (Hebrews 7:26-27). In that respect He is the fulfilment of not only the Passover lamb but of the Yom Kippur atoning sacrifices.

When we turn to God our heart, mind, eyes, and ears, must be focused on God. Jesus the Christ should have our attention and affection. The desire and motivation of our hearts must be to be with him and to please him, because of his loves for us

which is eternal, and we should therefore love and obey Him. “Nothing can separate us from the love of God”.

Our lawlessness has separated us from our God; And sins have hidden His face from us ...” (Romans 8:38, Isaiah 59:2). The word of God says that “all have sinned” (Romans 6:23). Without the shedding of blood our sins could not be covered. If sin is left without wholehearted repentance, it will separate us from our God and Saviour for ever. It must be addressed now before it is too late. (Philippians 2:12).

Repentance

As we in prayer, read and feed on the Word of God, seeking his face, we are convicted by the Holy Spirit, of our sin showing us the need for repentance and cleansing by blood of the Lamb. God then by his mercy and grace clothes us in His righteousness.

Humility

We must come before God in humility. This means we must come as one in need but lacking the power to help themselves and reliant on the mercy of another. It also requires that pride in whatever form is relinquished.



The church that prays for revival prays for a great awakening (Acts 3:19-20).

I began to pray about the dream and the Lord gave me these Scriptures - Jeremiah 4:3-4, Isaiah 58:6-9 Hosea 10:12 Psalms 34: 18

Acts 2:17 "And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams."

God is still fulfilling his promise; these are the last days.

Prior to the National revival meeting on the 4th November 2020 God laid it on the heart of our esteemed Bishop Copeland to oversee a "Day of Atonement". The day of atonement was held on 1st November 2020. This event was a wonderful precursor to the revival, as it was a time dedicated

to repentance, forgiveness, praise and worship.

Our revival covered 3 nights; 19:00 – 21:00 each night. Friday night's topic was, "The importance of revival" [Jer.4:3-4; Hos.10:12] We were reminded of the importance of returning back to our first love; to be on fire again for the Lord. Rev 2:4. Saturday night's topic was "A broken and a contrite heart" [Ps. 34:18]. The focus point was for us to submit to the Lord, and to go before him in repentance and humbleness of heart. 1 Pet. 5:6 "Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time."

Sunday night's topic was "Seeking God's face", this concluded our revival seminars. It was time for us to meditate on all we have learnt, the fervent dedicated prayers we had offered up to God, and the praises we had sent up with sincerity; we were seeking the face of God earnestly. Hosea 6:1-3 "Come, and let us return unto the Lord: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up.
